## **HOW WILL YOU BENEFIT?**

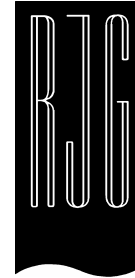

"Ready-To-Go" molds are scientifically and rigorously tested at the tryout shop. Cavity pressure sensors are selected and installed and a template created to be shipped with the mold. This creates a mold that is machine independent.

Another benefit is the ability to be remotely interactive with the molder while the process and templates are being determined.

Cavity pressure sensors and an eDART™ provide data in real-time for troubleshooting molds. A scientific tryout can quickly pinpoint inconsistencies in cavities and/or mold locations. Cavity pressure sensors are the only tool that provides you with a window into the mold.

- A minimum of one eDART™
- An RJG training series must be completed. The following training courses are required:
  - Systematic Molding for Mold Builders and Tooling Engineers or Sys I
  - Master Molder<sup>SM</sup> I & II
  - Rigorous Mold Tryout, In-Plant only
- An RJG-certified Master Molder<sup>SM</sup> must remain on staff in order to maintain Tryout Facility certification.
